Personal Paddock Vehicles (PPV) All motorized personal paddock vehicles (golf carts, four wheelers, etc) must be registered with NJMP and display a NJMP PPV sticker. Golf Cars are the only PPV that can be driven out of the paddock area to other parts of the facility. PPV permits will be available for NJMP in the Registration Center. LOCAL REGULATIONS:

- Any motorized paddock vehicle (team golf cars, 4-wheelers, scooters etc.) requires an event-specific paddock access sticker that is available at registration.
- All persons driving motorized vehicles in the paddock must be licensed drivers and have their driver's license available for inspection at all times.
- No 4-wheelers, scooters or non-licensed vehicles are allowed outside of the paddock area.
- No roller blades, roller skates, skateboards, non-motorized scooters or bicycles are allowed in the paddock or in any area of the New Jersey Motorsports Park facility.
- **NOISE CURFEW:** No race engines may be run before 8:00 a.m. or after 8:00 p.m. unless the official race schedule so dictates.
- **Speed limit in the paddock is 15 mph.** The speed on access roads is 25 mph. Race cars not licensed for street may not be driven outside the paddock. Absolutely no testing or brake bedding on infield roads is permitted.
- **No alcohol may be consumed in the paddock during the race day's racing events schedule**
- No stakes or holes may be driven into the asphalt. Nothing can be painted on the asphalt surface
