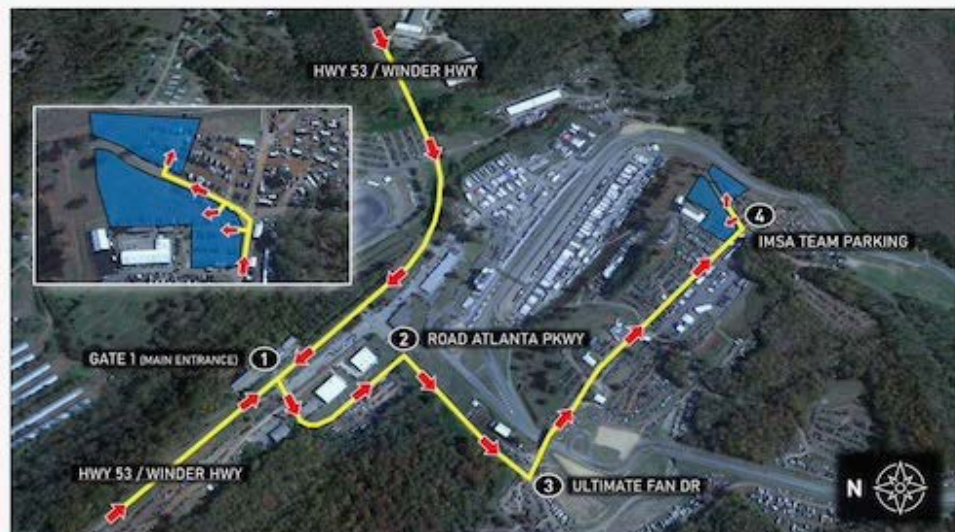

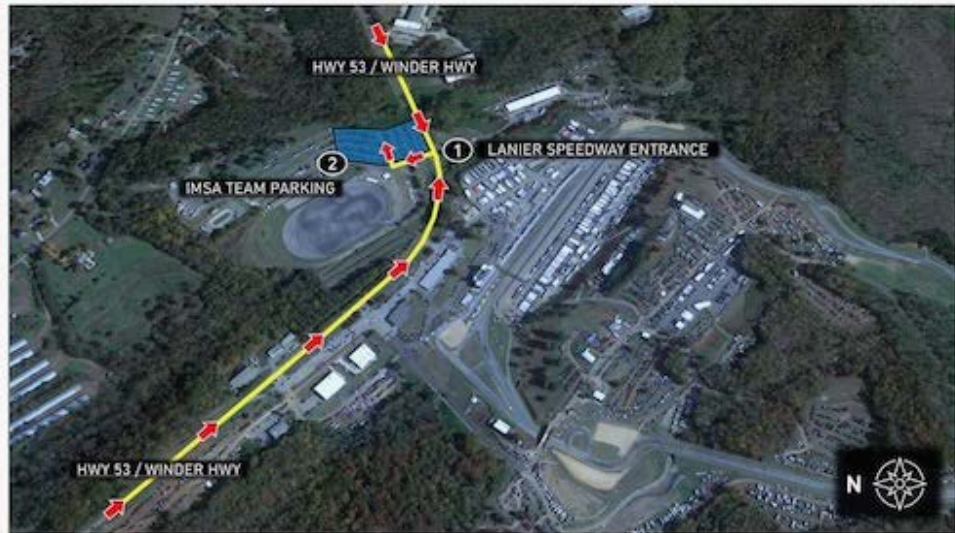


» TO IMSA TEAM PARKING (IMPC, VPRC, PCCNA, MX-5 PADDOCK)

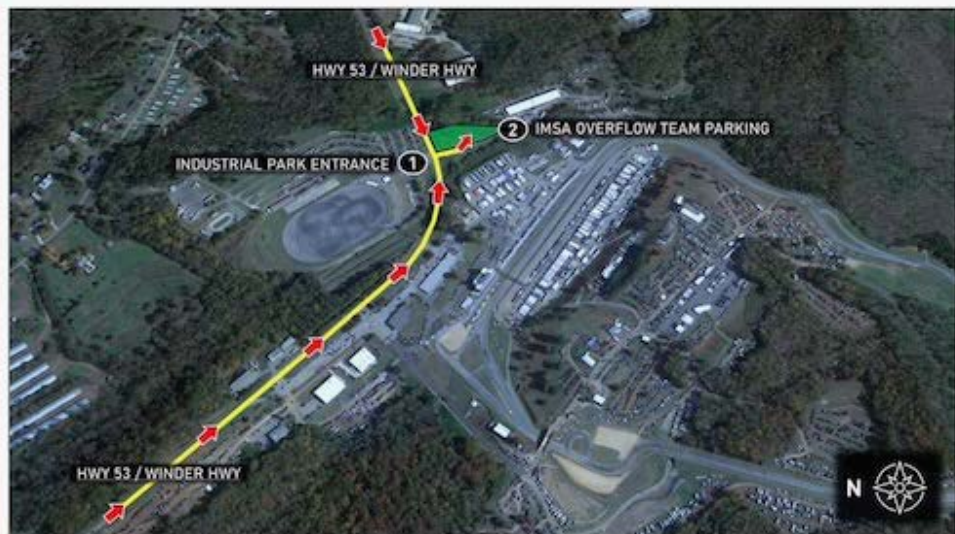


» TO IMSA TEAM PARKING (OVERFLOW)

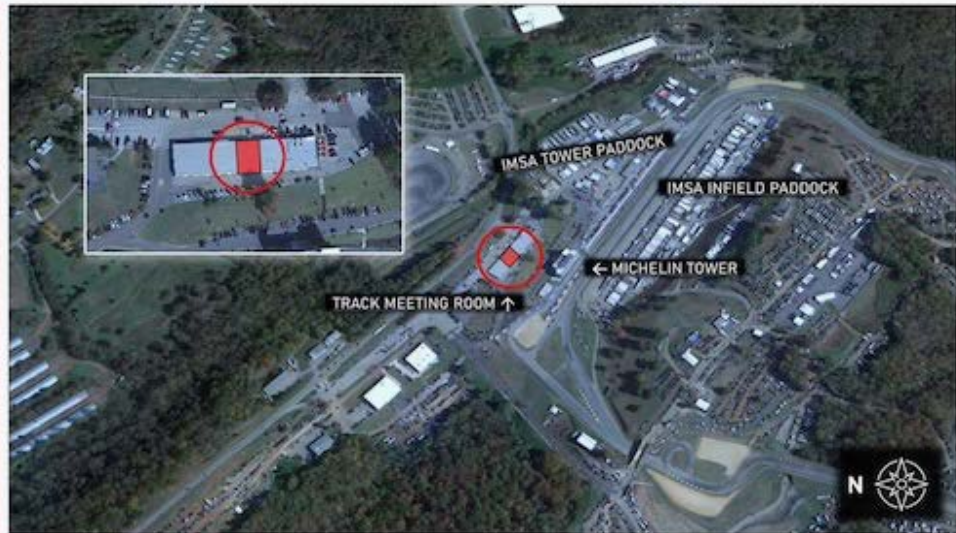


» TRACK MEETING ROOM
