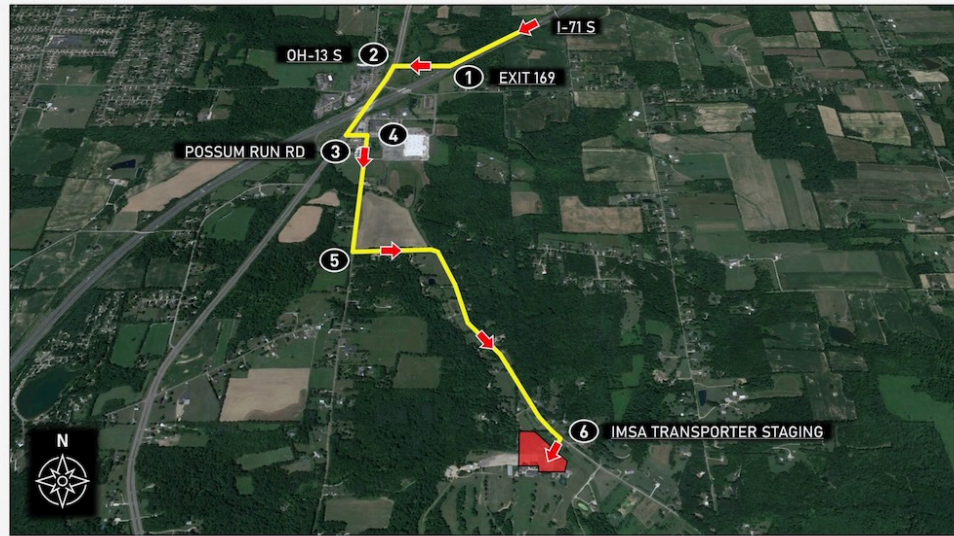

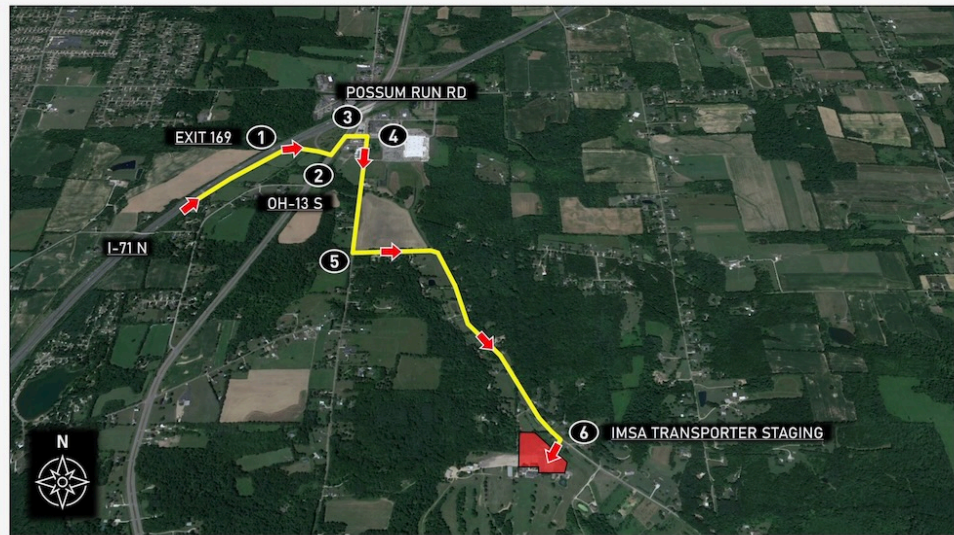

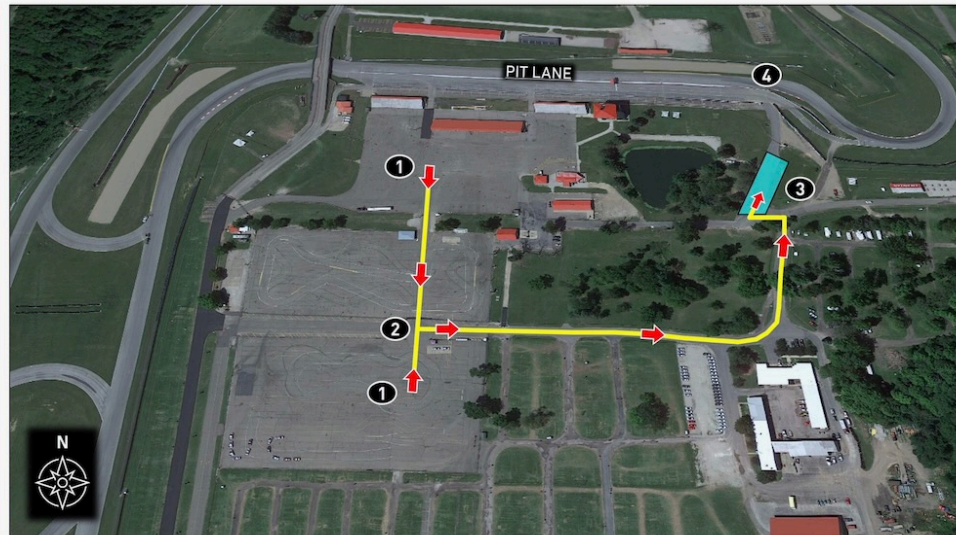


» TRAFFIC FLOW | TO FALSE GRID

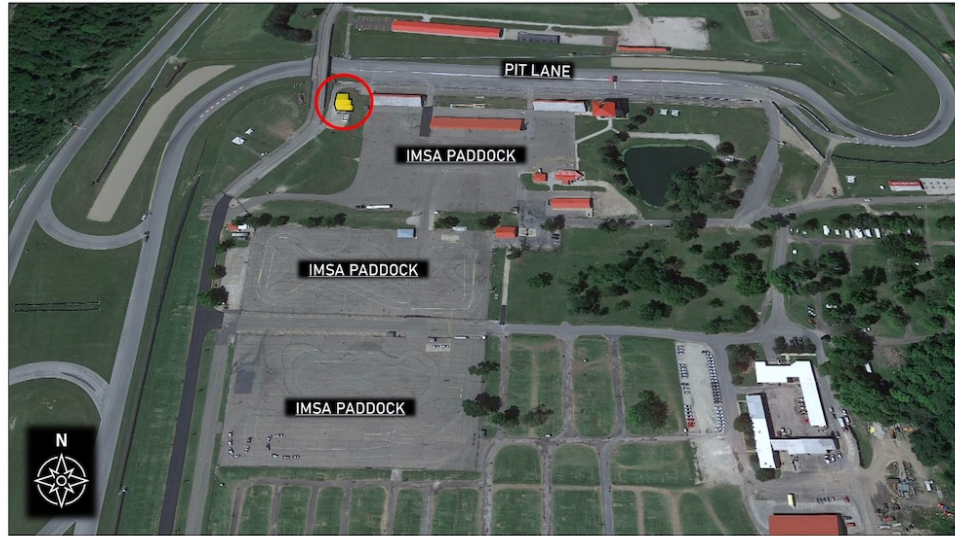


» CARE CENTER LOCATION
