


MX-5 CUP CAR FEATURES

The Mazda MX-5 Cup car is a purpose-built race car from 2018 / 2019 Mazda MX-5 known as the "ND" or fourth generation Miata.

With all prep work carried out by <u>FLIS Performance</u>, the car is completely disassembled, tub is cleaned of seam sealer and sound deadening material, an IMSA, INDYCAR, and SCCA approved roll cage is TIG welded into the car.

The car is assembled with over 250 race car-specific parts. The parts added to the car provide handling, endurance, safety and power enhancement specifically designed for the car after hundreds of hours and thousands of miles of both on-track and lab testing by automotive mechanical engineers and professional race car drivers. Component sealing and authentication tracking is done for parity in the various racing series in which the car competes.


